Gospel
John 20:1-9
He must rise from the dead

It was very early on the first day of the week and still dark, when Mary of Magdala came to the tomb. She saw that the stone had been moved away from the tomb and came running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one Jesus loved. 'They have taken the Lord out of the tomb' she said 'and we don't know where they have put him.'

So Peter set out with the other disciple to go to the tomb. They ran together, but the other disciple, running faster than Peter, reached the tomb first; he bent down and saw the linen cloths lying on the ground, but did not go in. Simon Peter who was following now came up, went right into the tomb, saw the linen cloths on the ground, and also the cloth that had been over his head; this was not with the linen cloths but rolled up in a place by itself. Then the other disciple who had reached the tomb first also went in; he saw and he believed. Till this moment they had failed to understand the teaching of scripture, that he must rise from the dead.

Easter, to Christians, should be the most important celebration of the year. After all, Easter reminds us of what Jesus did and how He rose from the dead. It reminds us that God fulfilled His promises and sent a savior. Sometimes we go through the motions and forget why Easter is so significant.


NAPLAN

In Week 3 this term the children in Year 3 & 5 will participate in the National Assessment Program - Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN). The testing was conducted online with the exception of the Year 3 writing, which was still a paper and pen format. The assessment will begin on Tuesday May 10 and conclude on Thursday May 12. The children will be tested in reading, writing, language conventions (spelling & grammar) and numeracy.

Although this provides important information to our school about trends in student learning over time, it is a snapshot of any individual student's learning and should be considered in conjunction with our own school reports and the extensive data we collect on all children throughout the year.
